- 6. Attend AgForce events in their area.
- 7. Actively participate in Board and policy committees, as well as any other required external committees.
- 8. Uphold standards of behaviour as outlined in the Code of Conduct for Directors.
- 9. Comply with AgForce Policies and Procedures outlined in the Governance Manual.
- 10. Promote the membership of AgForce.
- 11. The relationship between a Director and AgForce is fiduciary, meaning each Director is to act in the best interests of AgForce to the exclusion of any personal interests.
