JOB PURPOSE

4. Work collaboratively within AgForce teams, including all commodities, regions, the Policy, and Communication team.
5. Attend Regional Council Meetings, including face-to-face and teleconferences.
6. Attend scheduled Board Meetings.
7. Actively participate in Board committees and other external committees as required.
8. Be ultimately responsible for the overall successful operations and governance of AgForce.
9. Uphold standards of behaviour as outlined in the Code of Conduct for Directors.
10. Comply with AgForce Policies and Procedures outlined in the Governance Manual.
11. Promote the membership of AgForce.
12. The relationship between a Director and AgForce is fiduciary, meaning each Director is to act in the best interests of AgForce to the exclusion of any personal interests
