JOB PURPOSE

- 1. The Regional President provides leadership for the region.
- 2. Chair the Regional Council Meetings.
- 3. Represent the interests and policies of AgForce in the broader community.
- 4. A Regional Council will meet as often as necessary to carry out its functions, with a minimum of four meetings per year.
- 5. Lead the Regional Council in support of the objectives, vision, and purpose of AgForce, as outlined in the Governance Manual.
- 6. Work collaboratively within AgForce teams, including all Commodities, Regions, Policy, and Communications teams.
- 7. Enable regional perspectives to be considered by the Board and lead regional policy discussions with the aim of making policy recommendations.
- 8. Participate actively in the regions they represent, including attending as many regional events as possible.
- 9. Uphold standards of behaviour as outlined in the Code of Conduct for Regional Presidents.
- 10. Comply with AgForce Policies and Procedures outlined in the Governance Manual.
- 11. Promote the membership of AgForce.
- 12. Regional Presidents may or may not also serve as Regional Directors.
